



## Communication and Media ITO moderation principles

## The moderation system should:

- 1. protect the integrity of the industry sector qualifications;
- 2. suit the culture of the particular industry sector;
- 3. align with the NZQA requirements;
- 4. support mutual trust between all participants in the moderation process;
- 5. be able to be applied across a broad range of providers;
- 6. ensure best practice moderation processes while maintaining the requirements of the NZJTO;
- 7. support assessment that is fair, valid, and consistent;
- support 'best practice' in assessment, which includes using an integrated method of assessment, based around an evidence collection model;
- provide opportunities for professional discussion on assessment, as an integral part of the teaching and learning process;
- 10. guide the continuous improvement of assessor and moderator performance;
- 11. foster effective feedback on the moderation outcomes
